

Cat Personality Questionnaire

This is based on the questionnaire in Natural Cat Care by Dr Bruce Fogle. It is designed to be printed (use draft mode to save ink!) and give a more accurate analysis of our cat's personality that gut feel allows.

Scoring:

- Almost always = 5
- Usually = 4
- Sometimes = 3
- Rarely = 2
- Almost never = 1

Interpretation:

- 90-120 = cat personality is confident, outgoing, assertive.
- 56-89 = mid-range, reasonably confident, neither confident nor timid.
- 24-55 = more shy, timid, introverted.

Cat Personality Questionnaire - Notes: A cat's personality is partly inherited and partly developed through experience. Selective breeding of purebred cats has affected a cat's personality although breeders tend to breed for appearance primarily. Different breeds tend towards different personalities but individual cat personalities probably outweigh the differences breed to breed. There is a difference between the sexes too. Cats are generally solitary animals but have adapted to domestication.
